The purpose of hosting a Pink Ribbon Breakfast is to help raise money for families that are living with breast cancer. On May 12th Good Seed Trust had the honour of hosting our very first Pink Ribbon Breakfast, and what a tremendous success it was!!! This will definitely be a permanent fixture on the Good Seed Trust annual calendar and we look forward to hosting many more!! Breast cancer is a respecter of no-one and nearly all of us have either been personally affected by cancer or someone we love and are close to has. In light of this, it was a real privilege to bring this event to the South Auckland community. Historically this is not a place where Pink Ribbon Breakfasts have been hosted even though South Auckland women are amongst the worst, statistically, in New Zealand for not attending regular check ups.
